

COVID-19 Impact

In the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic and contingency plan enacted for the Spring 2020 term, the CCCAA has created eligibility exceptions. These impact students differently based on first competition. Please use this guide as a framework for processing eligibility in 2021-22



BUCKETS







Spring 2019 or Prior

If a student triggered first competition in Spring 2019 or prior they will need to present the following:

- 1. 24 units overall, 18 of which will need to be in academic courses as stated in Bylaw 1.3.1.B and 1.6.1.2
- 2. A cumulative 2.0 GPA including all units attempted from first competition.



Fall 2019

If a student triggered first competition in Fall 2019 they will need to present the following:

- 1. 18 units overall, 12 of which will need to be in academic courses as stated in Bylaw 1.3.1.B and 1.6.1.2
- 2. A cumulative 2.0 GPA including all units attempted from first competition.



Spring 2020

If a student triggered first competition in Spring 2020 and were in good academic standing at the time the season was ended, they will need to present the following:

1. Meet enrollment requirements for the term of competition and any additional eligibility requirements.


Note: Student-athletes season of competition was reinstated by the CCCAA



Spring 2020 NGS

If a student triggered first competition in Spring 2020 and were **NOT** in good academic standing at the time the season was ended, they will need to present the following:

- 1. 24 units overall, 18 of which will need to be in academic courses as stated in Bylaw 1.3.1.B and 1.6.1.2
- 2. A cumulative 2.0 GPA including all units attempted from first competition.



2020-2021

If a student triggered first competition in the 2020-2021 academic year, the CCCAA did not charge the studentathlete with a season of competition.

The student-athlete needs to meet enrollment requirements as a first time competitor for the 2021-22 academic year and any additional applicable bylaws.



RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

DIFFERENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FALL 2021 AND SPRING 2022

Fall 2021:

Transfer requirement remains at three (3) academic units for Fall 2021. These units must be academic units

Spring 2022:

If a student-athlete wishes to transfer and compete for Spring 2022, they would need to meet the normal residency requirement, which is 12 units. Only 8 of which can be completed during intersession (Summer/Winter) See Bylaw 1.10 for transfer language.

ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS THE BIG THREE

Ed Plans

Ed Plans dates have not changed and are still in effect for all student-athletes. Fall sport SA's will need an Ed Plan on file by October 15, and Spring sport SA's need to have their Ed Plan on file by March 1.

Enrollment

Student-athletes are once again required to enroll in your institution as a full-time student in order to compete. All student-athletes must be enrolled in 12 total units, 9 of which must be academic coursework.

Form 1 & 3 Submission

Commissioners are requesting Form 1/3's be submitted a minimum of 48 hours prior to first competition for review. Please keep this in mind when submitting and processing eligibility paperwork.

TRANSFER ELIGIBILITY DECISIONS

Any ruling/decision related to transfer eligibility used, will be enforced based on the guidelines set forth by the transfer institutions governing body.



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
